"ASSERTIVE, FEMININE, APPROACH"

TOGA's SS24 collection uses motifs that are typically considered 'feminine' such as lace, ribbons, pink and rounded silhouettes in combination with deliberately contrasting elements.

Lace, for example, is painted with black and blue pigment. Tailored pieces are open at the chest to reveal lingere. Shirring and curved shapes, conventionally used to show delicate volume, are distorted to take away their softness.

These contrasting elements are used to assertively depict the co-existence of self-affirmation and criticism and the instability of mind and body experienced by women.
